



Minutes of a meeting of the Aylesbury Youth Town Council (AYTC) held on Thursday 1 August, 2024, held on Microsoft Teams at 5:09pm

Due to the meeting scheduled for 24 July not reaching quorum, this additional meeting was scheduled.

1. Apologies for absence

Apologies received from Cllrs Leung, Nowak, Walsh.

2. Minutes

Resolved: The Youth Town Council unanimously agreed to accept the minutes of 25 June 2024, as a true record.

3. Matters arising

AYTC Clerk reported that project WhatsApp groups had been set up and project leaders should use these as the main channel of communication and to set up further meetings for their working parties, as required.

AYTC's planned visit to The PACE Centre will likely take place in September with the potential for a secondary visit in November.

4. Talk from The Mayor of Aylesbury

The Mayor was unable to attend due to a last-minute rescheduling of AYTC's monthly meeting from 24 July 2024 to 1 August 2024.

5. The PACE Centre dress-down campaign

Cllr Eke, provided an update on the planned timeline of delivery with aspirations to send invitations to schools and organisations in November/December with an aim for the event delivery to happen within a designated week in January. Cllr Eke will seek wider feedback within the working party WhatsApp group regarding the designated colour for the dress-down campaign and the delivery week for the campaign. Cllr Utime volunteered to coordinate the informational video as a videographer due to his experience and skillset, Cllr Eke agreed.

6. Tea & coffee stall - Mayor's charity

AYTC Clerk provided a project update on behalf of Cllr Walsh. Both Friars Square and St Marys Church had been contacted as potential venues for the stall and no response has been received. Cllr Walsh shared a desire to follow up with the venues but he would like to confirm a selection of potential delivery dates before doing so. Cllr Walsh noted that Heritage Open Days were happening on 6, 7, 13 and 14 September so the stall will likely be delivered at the end of September or start of October.

7. Parklife glitter stall

Cllr Nowak is the project lead for the PACE glitter stall at Parklife. AYTC Clerk updated that planning is progressing well with tasks clearly allocated. The pricing structure for the activity is under review to ensure costs are easily recovered for resources to maximise fundraising revenue. Cllr Kumar suggested a tiered donation structure with bigger tattoos at a higher price.

8. Date for October meeting

Cllrs discussed and agreed Wednesday 16 October, 2024, for the October monthly meeting.

9. Date of next meeting
